

Adopt-a-Highway

Watch this safety video to get an idea of what “Adopt-a-Highway” entails:

Identify whether you’re requesting to provide clean-up on a State, County or Town road:

- STATE highways are identified with numbers like Hwy 67 or 28
- Dodge COUNTY highways are identified with letters like Hwy V or TW
- TOWN highways are identified with names like Bay View or Wool

There are two **permits** available for download.

- Adopt-a-Highway should be used for STATE or COUNTY highways. See contact info below.
- Adopt-a-Road should be used for Williamstown roads. Contact info is on the application.

Also available are the forms (State/County or Town) to report your clean-up sessions and forms to “abandon” your “adoption (State/County or Town). **Use the contacts below if reporting on a State or County highway.**
