

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING BOUNDARY NEGOTIATIONS  
WITH THE CITY OF MAYVILLE

WHEREAS, the Town and the Village of Kekoskee are in the process of developing a cooperative plan that would provide for the attachment of the entirety of the Town by the Village; and

WHEREAS, the Town and Village have, today, approved a proposed cooperative plan and will be submitting it to the Wisconsin Department of Administration for approval under Wis. Stat. § 66.0307; and

WHEREAS, during the statutory public comment period on the proposed cooperative plan, the City of Mayville submitted a letter to the Town and Village indicating its interest in negotiating with the Town and Village for a possible boundary arrangement that involves all three parties; and


WHEREAS, the Town is willing to participate in such negotiations provided that negotiations do not impede the Department of Administration's review and approval of the cooperative plan.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Town Board of the Town of Williamstown does hereby authorize all necessary and appropriate Town officials, as well as the Town's attorneys, planners, and engineers, to participate in negotiations with the City of Mayville regarding a possible boundary arrangement involving the Town, the Village of Kekoskee, and the City of Mayville; and

FURTHER RESOLVED, that during the negotiations, the Town will continue to pursue approval by the Department of Administration of the proposed cooperative plan between the Town and the Village of Kekoskee.
